- **Supports abortion-on-demand.**
- **Has a zero percent pro-life voting record during her time in Congress,** according to National Right to Life.
- Voted in favor of taxpayer funding of abortion.
- **Voted against a motion to consider the Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act,** which would require ordinary care and protection for newborn babies who survive abortion.
- **Voted for the "Women's Health Protection Act,"** which would eliminate nearly all protections for unborn children across the country, including laws protecting unborn babies who feel pain and laws ensuring parental notification prior to abortion performed on a minor.
